## New This Year

### Upper School Day 9:

In coordination with the Middle School, there will be regularly scheduled days when all students will remain off campus. Teachers will, however, be available for office hours from 10 am–noon.

Day 9 may also be used for catching up, working ahead, asynchronous activities assigned by teachers, club meetings, or other Harley-based activities. The campus will meanwhile get a thorough cleaning.

### Community Time

Appended to lunch, Community Time replaces Upper School's traditional end-of-the-day Advisory Period. Daily Community Time may be used for advisor or club meetings, as well as all-school or class meetings or other school programming such as Social Emotional Learning.

## Face Coverings

Harley will require ALL students to wear an acceptable face covering as defined by the CDC at all times while on campus.

Acceptable face coverings include but are not limited to cloth-based face coverings (e.g., homemade sewn, quick cut) and surgical masks that cover both the mouth and nose. **No masks with valves, gaiters, or bandanas.**

Face coverings must be worn so that both the mouth and nose are covered at all times.

Additional supplies of disposable face coverings are available at the front entrance and nurse's office for those who arrive on campus without an appropriate face covering.
